This year will be a **BIG** year for MiCHWA. This summer, MiCHWA turns five, we report results from our second <u>statewide employer survey</u> (watch for it next week!), and we celebrate our third <u>CHW Appreciation Month</u>. We will also be experiencing some big organizational changes.

NEW OPPORTUNITIES

Staffing: In August, Project Director Katie Mitchell will be stepping down from her role after almost five years of service. Katie has served as MiCHWA's main staffer since launch. **Our search for a new project director begins now**, and our <u>job posting is</u> <u>officially posted here</u> (#124273). At present, the position will continue to be housed by the University of Michigan School of Social Work.

<u>Host Organization</u>: MiCHWA is also considering long-term sustainability. Later this month, MiCHWA's Steering Committee will release a **request for proposals** seeking a new organization interested in hosting MiCHWA. UM-SSW has been a wonderful host, and we will continue partnership with the school. We are looking to expand our services and activities, however, and are interested in options beyond an academic setting. CURRENT MiCHWA ACTIVITY

CHW Certification: MiCHWA's CHW Registry will launch later this year. The registry will be the mechanism through which CHWs are certified by MiCHWA. Upcoming Statewide Survey: MiCHWA will re-launch its <u>statewide survey</u> of CHW programs and their employers **April 20** in partnership with the <u>Michigan Department</u> <u>of Health and Human Services</u>. This survey will gather data on where CHWs are employed, what they do, and what professional development needs exist. Watch for it!
