

Open Call: NACHW Ambassadors 2025

The National Association of Community Health Workers (NACHW) seeks interested CHWs (Promotores, Community Health Representatives, etc.) to become **NACHW Ambassadors**. NACHW is seeking (1) CHW per state; all states are welcome to apply. The Ambassadors meet monthly and give updates on activities in their state. These positions will be a two-year commitment.

To Apply

Interested CHWs (Promotores, Community Health Representatives, etc.) should secure **two letters of recommendation**: (1) from their local, state, or regional CHW networks or associations to apply and (1) letter of recommendation from an employer organization, co-workers, supervisors, colleagues, etc. The nomination letters must come from someone other than the CHW applicant and will be evaluated based on the following criteria.

- The number of years of experience as a community health worker, Promotoras, community health representatives (CHRs), or similar role (minimum two years). Experience may be paid, volunteer, or a combination of both, but must be in a CHW position that does not require a clinical license as a qualification;
- Level of engagement with their local, state, or regional CHW association or network;
- Examples of demonstrated leadership skills
- Demonstrated strong communication skills
- Statement of reason(s) why the CHW/promotores/CHRs applicant would be a great NACHW Ambassador and a brief description of his or her activities with their local, state, regional, and (or) national CHW organizations (500 words max)

CHWs selected as Ambassadors must commit to the following:

- Be a member of NACHW for at least 1 month prior to April 30th (annual dues \$20);
- Attend and participate in the Unity Conference, pending funding
- Participate fully in NACHW workshops during the Conference, including those specifically for NACHW Ambassadors, if applicable
- Recruit at least 20 CHWs for NACHW membership during your term.
- Present the NACHW slide deck to CHWs and allies at least once a year
- Attend monthly meetings to give updates on membership recruitment
- Duties above are expected to take 1-3 hours a month, depending on roles and responsibilities

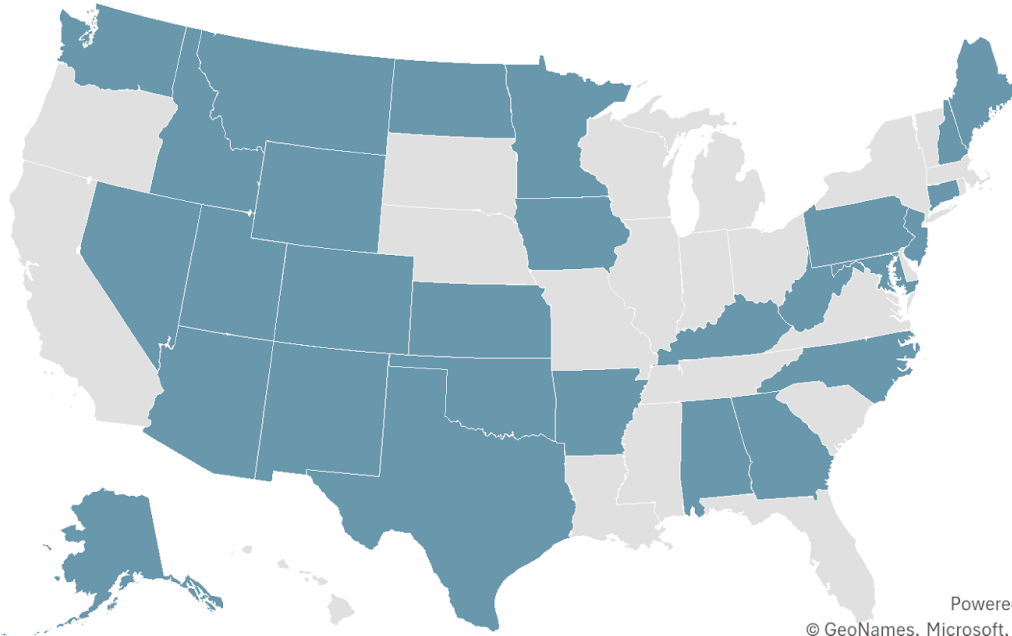
